VI. Business & Communications

A. Unfinished Business

1. The recent passage of a capital bill by the Illinois Legislature will provide a small boost to County MFT over the next 5 years, provided the bill stays in its' current form and the Governor signs it. Unfortunately the passage would also raise the weight limit on County and Township roads to 80,000#. The "small boost" is less than 5% of what the cost will be to improve and maintain local roads at the 80,000# limit. Local agencies may have the option to post their roads at 73,280 as a remedy to the increased damage by larger vehicles without making the necessary pavement improvements.
2. The Kings Crossing developer and the City of Rochelle are working together, with the County Engineer's input, on the phasing of proposed improvements to Flagg Rd / 20th Street intersection. The developer is interested in beginning construction on the intersection and 20th Street extension this Summer.
3. Bids are being taken on June 12th in Springfield on the Ogle County Stimulus project, microsurfacing of Freeport and Milledgeville Roads.
