 1. The Township Sealcoat program was completed the week of August 31.
 2. The Committee reviewed the layout plans for the proposed equipment storage building.
 3. The County Engineer discussed the results of the Eagle Point Road

drainage study with the Committee. Summarizing the report: If there was no structure on Eagle Point or Brookville Roads and the waterway was left to flow on its' own, the water elevation of the 25, 50, and 100 year events would all be higher than the lowest floor elevation of the adjacent home. The County Engineer will continue to review the study for other drainage impacts on a nearby structure.

4. Next week, the FHWA Discretionary Stimulus TIGER grant application will be submitted for the Rochelle Southwest Truck Loop by the City of Rochelle, Lee County Highway Dept, and Ogle County Highway Dept. The grant will request 100% funding for the \$37M project. Announcements of the selected projects will be made by February 17, 2010. This project would include improvements to Jack Dame, Center, Thorpe, Brush Grove, and Gurler Roads.
5. States Attorney Ben Roe has received additional information regarding the responsible bidder ordinance. The new information does not substantially change the provisions of the proposed ordinance.
6. The Engineering Technician's truck repairs have been made and it is back in service.
7. All Summer employees have left for the year. A couple completed projects from this Summer were the digital scanning of all right-of-way deeds and plats from the Courthouse and also the digital scanning of all County Highway construction drawings and plats.
