1. Call Meeting to Order: Chairwoman Nordman called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m. Present: Fox, Smith and Sulser. Others: Coroner Lou Finch, Sheriff Brian VanVickle, Typer, Heuer and Corbitt (arrived at 3:16). Absent: Droege.
2. Approval of Minutes – November 13, 2018: Motion by Smith to approve the minutes as presented, 2nd by Sulser. Motion carried.
3. Public Comment: None
4. Monthly Bills
 - Review of Department Billing: Motion by Smith that the credit card/department billing has been reviewed, 2nd by Fox. Motion carried.

5. Coroner Report: Coroner Lou Finch stated they have had 43 deaths since last month. The Grant Fund balance is \$5,493.88 and the Cremation Fund balance is \$4,540.02. Coroner Finch gave an overview of his office for the new members.
6. Sheriff Report: Sheriff Brian VanVickle went over his reports; they are currently down 3 deputies. Sheriff VanVickle stated training will be held in January; 2 employees from Corrections will transition to Patrol and then have one new hire.

9. New Business
 - Revolving Car Fund Purchase: Sheriff VanVickle stated the vehicle has been ordered; it will not exceed \$125,000.

Nordman informed Sheriff VanVickle that she would like to have 911 ETSB Update added to the agenda; she would like him to keep the Committee updated on their meetings.

Sheriff VanVickle stated Verizon has requested a 6-month extension on the old tower; he has forwarded the request onto Chairman Gouker and City of Oregon Mayor Williams.
