

**County Security Committee
Tentative Minutes
October 9, 2018**

1. Call Meeting to Order: Vice-Chairman Gronewold called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m. Present: Colbert, Smith and Sulser. Others: Coroner Lou Finch, Sheriff Brian VanVickle, County Clerk and Recorder Laura Cook, Typer and Susie Corbitt. Absent: Nordman.
2. Approval of Minutes – September 11, 2018: Motion by Smith to approve the minutes as presented, 2nd by Colbert. Motion carried.
3. Public Comment: None
4. Monthly Bills
 - Review of Department Billing: Motion by Colbert that the credit card/department billing has been reviewed, 2nd by Sulser. Motion carried.
Sheriff: \$32,417.14 Emergency Communications: \$1,102.74
Corrections: \$4,063.17 OEMA: \$1,541.48
 - Sheriff: Motion by Smith to approve the bills totaling \$7,086.75, 2nd by Sulser. Motion carried.
 - Emergency Communications: Motion by Colbert to approve the bills totaling \$71.65, 2nd by Smith. Motion carried.
 - Corrections: Motion by Sulser to approve the bills totaling \$15,225.68, 2nd by Colbert. Motion carried.
 - OEMA: Motion by Colbert to approve the bills totaling \$1,228.74, 2nd by Smith. Motion carried.
 - Coroner: Motion by Smith to approve the bills totaling \$5,165.30, 2nd by Colbert. Motion carried.
5. Coroner Report: Coroner Lou Finch updates the committee of 35 deaths handled in the department last month. Finch says in the Cremation Fund there is \$5,230.76 and in the Grant Fund there \$5,493.88.

Finch went before the Personnel and Salary Committee this morning to replace a position as he had an employee leave the office. The Personnel and Salary Committee granted the position and will be at the Finance Committee tonight. Smith asks if he has a replacement in mind. Finch states he does; this person has experience with dealing with grief and families. The starting salary will be the same with no increase until FY2020.

Gronewold asks Finch if the communication with Hospice services has improved. Finch states they have had more and more cases of Hospice and they are not present when a call comes in. Finch updates on the indigents in the Coroner's Office.
6. Sheriff Report: The committee reviews the reports provided. Sheriff updates the committee on the Merit Commission and they will meet next week. The Sheriff has an immediate opening on Patrol and will have a couple more in the next couple of months. The department is running with minimum staffing at this time.

8. Closed Session: None

9. New Business

- Review of Ordinance: 12-4-1: Vehicle Impound Ordinance (O-2011-1008, 10-19-2011): Sheriff VanVickle says the Tow Fund Fee is used to purchase and maintain squad cars. He has reviewed other counties in the area and we are the lowest at \$350. Sheriff would like to see this increased to \$500. He would also like to see the number of days to dispose of an impounded vehicle from 30 days to 10 days. Sheriff explains the process of the towing companies need to do to dispose of the vehicles. Motion by Smith to increase the Tow Fee to \$500 and 10 days in impound, 2nd by Sulser. This will be recommended to the Finance Committee this evening. Motion carried.
- Sulser asks the Sheriff about the Tornado Sirens near his home; he cannot hear them in his house and asks if this is his jurisdiction. Sheriff states no, since Sulser lives within the City of Rochelle. Sheriff also states the sirens are only for outside notification.

10. Adjournment: With no further business, Vice-Chairman Gronewold adjourned the meeting. Time: 3:30 p.m.
