New Business:

➤ Maxson's Restaurant:

Chairman Gouker presents and reviews the applications for Maxson's Restaurant. The Sheriff has reported that the background check was clear and no felonies, states Gouker. The State's Attorney has stated based on the oral report of the Sheriff, he has no problems with the applications.

State's Attorney Mike Rock there was a question regarding residency for applicants; however it does not apply to Corporations only individuals. It has been noted that the Semmerlings are apply for the Liquor License as a Corporation.

Chief Deputy Laura Cook notes the reports from the Health Department and Zoning show no problems with the issuance of a license at the restaurant.

Chairman Gouker would like have a prorated refund to the previous owners of Maxson Riverside Restaurant for the remainder of the year. Cook clarifies for 2014 and Chairman Gouker states yes.

Finfrock moves to approve the issuance of an Ogle County Liquor License to Semwieg, Inc for Maxson's Restaurant, 2nd by Gronewold – motion carried.
