WHEREAS, Illinois law pursuant to 55 ILCS 5/5-12020 (Wind Farms) provides that a county may establish standards for wind farms and electric-generating wind devices, and may also regulate the siting of wind farms and electric-generating wind devices; and

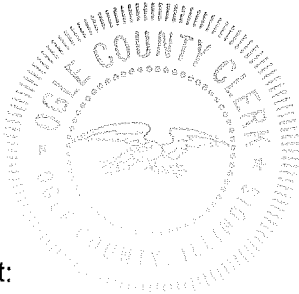
WHEREAS, Senate Bill 3263 (the Wind Energy Facilities Construction and Deconstruction Act) would transfer the authority to establish standards for and regulate the siting of wind farms and electric-generating wind devices from counties to the Illinois Department of Agriculture; and





WHEREAS, Mr. Meyer desires and requests the consent of this County Board to this action; and



RESOLUTION 2014-0424
Resolution to Create a Fund for the Receipt and
Disbursement of Administrative Tow Fees

WHEREAS, the government of the County of Ogle, State of Illinois, has a responsibility of certain and specific duties for the good of the public welfare of its citizens, and such responsibility being vested with the County Board of the County of Ogle, and

WHEREAS, at its October 19, 2011 regular meeting, the Ogle County Board recognized the need to offset the financial costs associated with the investigation of criminal offenses involving motor vehicles, and the towing, impounding, or seizing of motor vehicles used during the commission of criminal, traffic, or related offenses with the County of Ogle, and

WHEREAS, at that same meeting, the Ogle County Board adopted Ordinance 2011-1008, which created an Administrative Fee to offset those financial costs, and since such time has been collecting that fee, and expending funds from those collected fees, and

WHEREAS, in its normal course of operation, it is customary that the County Board of Ogle, will create a Fund, by the adoption of a Resolution which outlines the guidelines for collection and disbursement of certain fees, and the Ogle County Board recognizes that such a Fund, for the collection and disbursement of the Administrative Fee enacted with Ordinance 2011-1008, has not heretofore been officially created.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Board of Ogle County, State of Illinois on this 15th day of April, 2014, that the Ogle County Board will create and establish, and maintain, an Administrative Tow Fee Fund, for the purpose of collecting such fees, and expending funds, as outlined by Ogle County Board Ordinance 2011-1008, and amended by Ordinance 2014-0202.

FURTHERMORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Board of Ogle, State of Illinois, that deposits to the Tow Fund, will be limited to only the Administrative Fee enacted by Ordinance 2011-1008, and that the oversight of deposits and expenditures of such fees to and from this Tow Fund will be the responsibility of the committee of the Ogle County Board, with which the Ogle County Sheriff's General Fund budget is reviewed on a regular, monthly basis, and that the reporting of all activity of the Tow Fund will be done through the office of the Ogle County Treasurer.

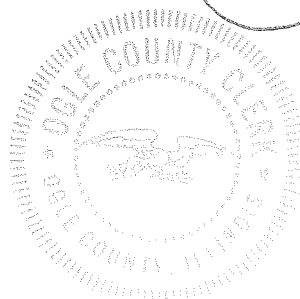



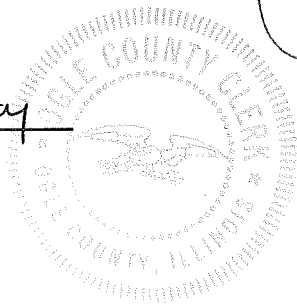
