**Call to Order**

Chairman Gocken calls the meeting to order at 5:35 p.m.

**Roll Call**

**NITT Presentation - Ryan Alderks of RMU (Rochelle Municipal Utilities)**

Chairman Gocken introduces Ryan Alderks to the board to discuss the NITT Resolution and Intergovernmental Agreement which has been presented to the board. Alderks states this fiber optic connectivity will be an Economic Development engine to our rural area. This resource will enable us to retain the businesses we currently have in our rural communities. This Intergovernmental Agreement presented tonight will provide your community, county or educational facilities the connectivity they need to provide the type of services that they have in downtown Chicago. Alderks states the NITT Commission is seeking a contribution of \$50,000 from each agency. There was discussion regarding maximum contributions and the weighted votes. Lewandowski points out a typo-graphical error on page 8 regarding the Indemnification of the Intergovernmental Agreement. County Administrator Mielke states it should be Section 8.6 and 8.4, not 7.6 or 6.4 as presented. This change will be clarified before the county signs the agreement. Rice moves to approve the Resolution authorizing an Intergovernmental Agreement between Ogle County and certain other Public Agencies for the formation of the Northern Illinois Technology Triangle Commission. Hopkins seconds and the motion carries on a voice vote.(Placed on file)Hopkins moves to approve the Intergovernmental Agreement establishing the Northern Illinois Technology Triangle Commission with corrections to Section 7.2 - Indemnification clause refer to sections 8.6 and 8.4 instead of 7.6 and 6.4 as presented in the original document. County Administrator Salary

Chairman Gocken states when Jim Mielke was hired as the Ogle County Administrator, it was agreed he would be reviewed in November before the budget was approved. On November 16<sup>th</sup> the Interview Committee which comprised of Chairman Gocken, Pat Saunders, Skip Kenney and Shirley Clayton met with Mr. Mielke. It was determined since Mr. Mielke has been here for a short time, the committee would not use the Performance Evaluation they had since that would not be applicable. They used the Position Description which was used as part of the hiring procedures. Mr. Mielke's job performance met standards or was above standards. Chairman Gocken states Mr. Mielke has lightened her job considerably as Chairman and has familiarized himself by attending all committee meetings, familiarized himself with all county properties and made the budget process run smoothly. Chairman Gocken states the review committee agreed they were all pleased with his

performance. At the committee meeting, Saunders makes the recommendation to increase the County Administrator's salary by 6.1% (the same percentage as other department heads) to \$85,000 beginning December 1, 2006. Chairman Gocken moves to increase the salary of the County Administrator to \$85,000 beginning December 1, 2006. Saunders seconds and the motion carries on a voice vote.

Judicial Center Update

Chairman Gocken states there is no update from GreenAssociates regarding the Judicial Center.

Judicial Center bills

Chairman Gocken states the Judicial Center bills presented tonight for a total of \$24,590.11. Long Range Capital Improvement Fund Spending Policy

Chairman Gocken states there has been a memo drafted to the Ogle County Board members from County Administrator Jim Mielke regarding a proposed guideline for the Long Range Capital Improvement Fund Spending Policy. Chairman Gocken reads the following proposed guidelines:

- 1 - Type of Expense - One time, non-reoccurring capital infrastructure expenditures. For example, normal day to day operational expenses such as insurance, wages supplies and vehicles are not eligible.
- 2 - A capital request will be made by the Department Head in conjunction with preparation of the fiscal year budget. The original request would be made through the County Administrator, followed by recommendation by the Executive and Finance Committee. Final approval would be determined by the County Board.
- 3 - Expenditures will be reviewed by the County Administrator followed by the presentation to the Executive Committee. The Executive Committee will make a recommendation to the County Board. The County Board has final approval.

Kenney moves to approve the proposed guidelines as presented, Saunders seconds and the motion carries on a voice vote.(Placed on file)
