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OGLE COUNTY OVERSIZE AND OVERWEIGHT PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

I. Remittance

- a) Payment for permit fees may be in the form of a certified, cashier's, company or personal check, credit card or postal or telegraphic money order made payable to "Ogle County Treasurer." Payments in currency must be made in person. Permit fees must be paid in advance unless the applicant has an approved account with the Permit Office or has made other satisfactory arrangements for payment.
- b) The Highway Department will charge a service fee of \$25 for a check returned for any reason.

II. Exemption to the Requirement of Payment of Fees

The requirement for payment of fees shall not apply to vehicles owned and operated by the United States, this state or any political subdivision or municipality of this state. However, a permit must still be obtained.

III. Security Requirements

If requested by the Highway Department before a permit is issued, the applicant will be required to secure an Irrevocable Letter of Credit or other designated form of security in favor of Ogle County in an amount sufficient to cover any damages to the highway system that may be caused by the proposed movement. The security will be retained until the damages are determined and repairs completed.

IV. Basis for Fees

Permit fees will be based upon the fee schedules as approved by any of the agencies that are part of this program and may differ from agency to agency. Ogle County will also charge an additional processing fee.

V. Fee for Engineering Inspections and Investigations

The following additional fees will be charged for engineering inspections and investigations that may be necessary due to the size or weight of the load.

For normal engineering inspections and investigations, all or a portion of the following:

- 1) Bridge structural analysis -\$100 per hour plus computer costs.
- 2) Pavement structural analysis -\$70 per hour.
- 3) Field investigation of movement feasibility -\$40 per hour.
- 4) Interim or final inspection for damages -\$40 per hour.
- 5) Computer usage time -\$25 per hour.

VI. Fees for Law Enforcement Escorts

The following fees for the use of Law Enforcement escorts shall be paid separately by the applicant to the "Ogle County Treasurer": \$75 per hour per vehicle.

VII. Permit Types

Ogle County oversize/overweight vehicle permit is a general permit for all oversize/overweight loads as follows:

- Single Trip Permit
- Round Trip Permit (not to exceed 5 days)
A 5-day Round Trip Permit for movement to a site is valid only for the first day the permit is valid. The return trip must be made on the same designated route on any of the days remaining on the permit.
- Multiple Trip Permit (same day only)
A Multiple Trip Permit is valid only for one truck making multiple trips of the same load in one day.
