5. Coroner Report: Finch stated they have had 63 deaths since last month with 479 deaths year to date.
6. Sheriff Report: VanVickle stated their numbers are down but still comparable to last year. All 160 reservations for the Judicial Center Annex tours were filled. They still have a lot of work to do and training to be done before occupying the building. At the end of the month, Patrol Division will be at full staff. They will have more retirements next year. Oltmanns questioned the status of the body camera grants. VanVickle stated they were awarded the grant; however, the State withdrew it due to some documentation error. Later it was determined that the error was on the State's part but too late to receive the

grant.

8. New Business: VanVickle stated he has ordered 5 vehicles and there are still 6 cars left to replace over the next 2 years.
