5. Coroner Report: Coroner Finch stated they have had 41 deaths since last month. Grant Fund and Cremation Fund have been exhausted.
6. Sheriff Report: VanVickle stated they have not seen an increase in calls except for domestic and runaways. Administration and Patrol are back to full operations. Maintenance is working at the Old Courthouse for installing safety precautions in preparation of re-opening. EOC has been very busy. VanVickle will have 2 retirements this month, one will need to be replaced. He has had one quit in the Jail and one is still in training in Patrol due to the closure of the training center. His budget will not be affected by the replacement of positions. Sulser asked about the status of the lawsuit. VanVickle stated it the Federal Courts are closed so it is at a standstill.
