EXTENSION OF RESTRICTION OF ACCESS TO THE OGLE COUNTY JUDICIAL CENTER


In light of Governor Pritzker's Executive Order extending the 'stay at home' directive through April 30, 2020, the March 23, 2020 Administrative Order 2020-5 restricting access to the Ogle County Judicial Center is extended through April 30, 2020.

As set forth therein no member of the public will be allowed in the Ogle County Judicial Center through April 30, 2020 absent specific order from the judiciary. Essential court staff will still be allowed access to conduct essential court business. Routine matters may still be heard remotely or by video conference with the presiding Judge's approval. Attorneys and their clients will be allowed access to the Ogle County Judicial Center for all approved essential emergency criminal or civil proceedings.

This extension is to further reduce the number of people coming into the Ogle County Judicial Center with the goal to protect the staff and general public during this pandemic.

This order may be supplemental as developments occur.
