TEMPORARY ORDER - TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF OGLE COUNTY JUDICIAL CENTER

Pursuant to the Illinois Supreme Court's March 17, 2020 Order MR 303070 In Re: Illinois Courts Response to COVID-19 Emergency, the Supreme Court Order of May 20, 2020 allowing Circuit Courts to step back from reopening plans as dictated by local conditions and the outbreak of COVID-19 within the Ogle County Judicial Center resulting in a recommendation on November 20, 2020, by the Ogle County Health Department to pause judicial proceedings for two weeks, November 23 through December 4, 2020, effective immediately and until further order of the Court:

1. All cases falling within that time frame are continued and parties will be notified of a future date.
2. During the period of temporary closure, limited staff will be available for criminal bond hearings, emergency matters regarding emergency petitions for order of protection, emergency orders for stalking/no contact, emergency juvenile matters and bonafide emergency child support and parenting time/decision making disputes. Determination of a bonafide emergency child support or parenting time/decision making dispute issue shall be determined by the Judge before whom the case is pending.
3. The Ogle County Judicial Center will reopen on Monday, December 7, 2020 at 8:30 a.m.
4. Upon reopening, all protective measures as set forth in Administrative Order 2020-25 dated November 20, 2020, and all protective measures stated within previous Administrative Orders remain in full force and effect.
