ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2021 - 7

COVID-19 POLICY AND PROCEDURE - WARRANTS

On November 18, 2020 Administrative Order 2020-23 was entered pursuant to the Illinois Supreme Court's March 17, 2020 Order MR 303070 and the Supreme Court Order of May 20, 2020 allowing Circuit Courts to step back from reopening plans as dictated by local conditions and whereas at that time there was a spike in the growth of COVID-19 in Ogle County justifying a modification in the treatment of outstanding warrants for misdemeanor, traffic and pay or appear warrants so as to limit the number of individuals being detained in the Ogle County Jail. And whereas since that time there has been a significant reduction in the growth and spread of COVID-19 in Ogle County and the new Ogle County Judicial Center Annex has opened and implemented additional conditions and procedures to limit the exposure of COVID-19 in the Ogle County Judicial Center Annex, it is therefore ordered the modifications and restrictions set forth in Administrative Order 2020-23 are revoked effective immediately and until further order of the Court.
