COVID-19 POLICY AND PROCEDURE - WARRANTS

Pursuant to the Illinois Supreme Court's March 17, 2020 Order MR 303070 In Re: Illinois Courts Response to COVID-19 Emergency, the Supreme Court Order of May 20, 2020 allowing Circuit Courts to step back from reopening plans as dictated by local conditions and the recent growth of COVID-19 in Ogle County, effective immediately and until further order of the Court:

1. Any outstanding warrants for misdemeanor (other than Domestic Battery, Violation of Order of Protection and Stalking/No Contact Orders), DUI (non-felony), DWLR and DWLS (non-felony) and traffic cases shall be modified upon arrest and processing to a \$1,000.00 recognizance bond with an appropriate court date assigned. The same shall apply to any pay or appear warrants upon arrest and processing.
2. Judges may refrain in appropriate circumstances from the issuance of bench warrants based upon the nature of the hearing, the case and their call.

This order may be supplement as developments occur.
