Dress Code Policy

All who enter the Ogle County Reporting Center Program are required to sign this document stating that he/she will follow the Dress Code Policy of the program. Upon signature you have agreed to not only following all of the Dress Code Policies, but will accept the consequences of your actions if you choose not to do so.

1. Absolutely no hats are to be worn while in the program or during scheduled activities. If a hat is worn to and from the program during cold weather, it should be appropriate and worn on top of the head facing the front.
2. Pants must fit appropriately.
 - Pants must stay at the waist without having to be pulled up. No oversized pants are allowed.
 - Absolutely no underclothing should ever be visible
 - Pants should not have large holes or tears in the legging area
 - No shorts or skirts shorter than 6 inches above the knee.
3. Appropriate shirts and clothing only-No obscene/sexual/alcohol/drug/smoking writing or pictures on clothing
 - No low cut or tight fitting shirts
 - No tank tops, halter tops, off the shoulder or midriff baring garments
4. Jewelry-necklaces are allowed, but only small pendants 1 inch or less can be worn. Girls and boys are only allowed to wear earrings in the ears, no other visible piercings will be allowed while in the program. All facial or other visible piercings must be removed before attending the program each day.
5. No accessories that can be used as a weapon, such as spiked wrist wear or rings, lengthy chain necklaces, including those attached to wallets.
6. No gang related colors, symbols, or signs are allowed. In addition, Rastafarian symbols/colors are not allowed.
7. All visible tattoos are to be covered with clothing or Band-Aids prior to arrival.
8. Hair is to be kept neat and clean.

By signing this document, you agree to not only follow the Dress Code Policy, but also accept the consequences of your actions. All infractions will be reported to your home school or appropriate authorities.
