Guidelines/Consequences

All who enter the Ogle County Reporting Center Program are required to sign this document stating that he/she will follow the guidelines of the program. Upon signature you have agreed to not only following all guidelines, but will accept the consequences of your actions if you choose not to do so.

1. No physical contact will be tolerated whatsoever. What you find to be just playing around may not be viewed that way by the other person. Invading the space of others causing them to feel uncomfortable is also not allowed.
2. Destruction of Reporting Center/Focus House property or property of other minors in the program will not be tolerated. Criminal or additional charges will be filed.
3. Theft of Reporting Center/Focus House property or property of other minors in the program will be tolerated. Criminal or additional charges will be filed.
4. Pockets, purses, book bags or any type of bag can and may be searched at any time. Minors found to have contraband will face consequences. Contraband consists of drug related items, marijuana, any type of pipe including vape pipes, and rolling papers. For anyone under the age of 18 caught with tobacco products, items will be confiscated and not returned to minor. All lighters will be confiscated, but will be returned to the minor at the end of the program.
5. All cell phones must be turned in at the beginning of the program and will be returned at the end of the program. No IPOD's/MP3 players, hand held games, or other electronic devices will be allowed. Items deemed inappropriate will be taken and returned at the end of the program or back to the parents.
6. When in county vehicles, all minors are required to wear seatbelts. Volume of voices and radio must be kept low; distracting the driver will not be tolerated. No food or beverage will be allowed in the vehicles. No minor will be allowed to use their phones while in the county vehicles, along with earbuds to listen to their music.
7. Youths are REQUIRED to bring their own food and drinks. All liquids brought into the OCRC must be sealed and all lunches will be checked by staff.
8. All minors are responsible for bringing school materials to work on each day while in the Reporting Center program.
9. Respectful behavior to staff and other participants in the program is required. This includes:
 - Eye contact when being spoken to
 - Appropriate tone of voice
 - Appropriate language (no swearing or slang)
 - No name calling/demeaning comments/no racial, gender. Sexual orientation, religious slurs
 - Responding to staff the first time asked
 - Refrain from negative body language

By signing this document, you agree to not only follow the guidelines, but also accept the consequences of your actions. All infractions will be reported to your home school or appropriate authorities.
