

# Ogle County Electronics Recycling Guidelines - Permit Required

Limit of 7 large items. Smaller items may be placed in a box and counted as one item. Please remove batteries from all devices. Dispose alkalines, recycle rechargeables.

Microwaves - \$5 each (cash or check made out to OCSWMD and taped to the microwave). No receipts will be given.

Hours are from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. for Friday events, 8:00 a.m to 12:00 p.m. for Saturday events.

Do not come early.

## **Covid-19 Precautions:**

Face masks are required.

Show your permit and identification.

To social distance, put all items in the trunk of your car, rear of your SUV or van, in the bed of a pickup truck, or on a trailer, and **stay in your vehicle.**
