City Carton Recycling, 4002 Kimmel Dr., Davenport, IA 52802, **800-369-6112**. Will work with large businesses and industries to provide a regular or as-needed pick-up service for baled or loose recyclables. Accepts wide variety of materials.

Commercial Waste Systems, P.O. Box 435, Crown Point, Indiana 46308, **219-663-5678**. Regular pick-up route through area for commercial & industrial customers with baled corrugated cardboard. Minimum 5 bales. Also offer balers and other equipment. Email: cws@commercialwastesystems.com

Freeport Recycling Center, 657 N Van Buren Rd., Freeport, IL 61032, **815-291-1290**. Commercial, residential, and industrial recycling services. All types of recycling. FRC will set up a program to collect corrugated cardboard, office paper, newsprint, printer's waste-paper, and industrial/commercial plastics.

MDK, Inc., 625 Klenske Ave., New Hampton, IA, **641-294-2129**. This company purchases the following recyclable materials: Paper Materials- newsprint, office paper, magazines, coated books, phone books, chip board, Plastic Materials- HDPE, PET, LDPE, PVC, polystyrene, polycarbonate, Metal Materials- copper, brass, steel cans, aluminum, scrap, Textiles- clothing, rags, shoes, toys. They will pick up and have no minimum load requirements.

Midwest Fiber Recycling, 422 S. White Oak Rd., Normal, IL, **309-452-0064**. Works with larger businesses to provide customized programs to reduce waste and recycle corrugated cardboard, office paper and other fiber, plastics, non-ferrous metals and other specialty items. Have regular route in area.

Paper Recovery Service, 7972 Crest Hills Dr., Loves Park, IL, **815-636-2329**. They currently have a regular route through Rochelle every two weeks to pick up material for recycling. They collect paper, corrugated cardboard, aluminum, steel cans, and some plastic. They may pay for some materials depending on quality, quantity, and market prices. Free containers can be provided for storage of materials between pickups (gaylords, totes or other containers depending on how much you generate).

The Peltz Group, Inc., 414-967-1800. They are based out of Milwaukee, WI but run a regular route through this area. Contact name: Andrew Mielke. This company recently merged with Waste Management Inc. and has recycling centers throughout the Midwest.
